**AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRACKING OF REGISTERED SEXUAL
OFFENDERS WHO MOVE OUT-OF-STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 969 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 whenever a person who has registered as a sexual offender changes
- 3 such person's address to an address out-of-state (1) such person shall
- 4 notify the police department for the town in this state where such
- 5 person resides of such person's planned change of residence and the
- 6 name of the town in the other state where such person plans to reside,
- 7 and (2) the police department for the town in this state where such
- 8 person resides shall notify the town in the other state where such
- 9 person plans to reside of such person's planned change of residence

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent sexual offenders from evading the registration
requirements of Megan's Law when they move out-of-state.
