AN ACT PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF LOCAL AND REGIONAL FETAL AND INFANT MORTALITY REVIEW PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2007*) (a) The sum of three hundred fifty
2 thousand dollars is appropriated to the Department of Public Health,
3 from the General Fund, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2008, and
4 June 30, 2009, respectively, to provide funds: (1) For the continued
5 operation of the five Fetal and Infant Mortality Review (FIMR)
6 programs serving Hartford, Manchester-Vernon, New Britain, greater
7 New Haven and Windham; and (2) for the establishment of five
8 additional such FIMR programs in at-risk, unserved communities.
9 Funding for each of said existing FIMR programs shall not be reduced
10 below the amount of funds received by each program for the fiscal
11 year ending June 30, 2006.

12 (b) The funds appropriated for FIMR programs in subsection (a) of
13 this section shall not be used for any other purpose, shall not be
14 transferred from this account by the Department of Public Health or
15 the finance advisory committee, and shall not be subject to allotment

16 reduction by the Governor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To require continued funding for five existing FIMR programs, provide funds for the establishment of an additional five such programs.
