**AN ACT CONCERNING REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF THE CHILD
POVERTY AND PREVENTION COUNCIL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That (1) section 4-67x of the general statutes be amended to require
2 the Child Poverty and Prevention Council to continue reporting
3 annually until January 1, 2015, to the Governor and certain committees
4 of the General Assembly on the state's progress in prioritizing
5 expenditures in budgeted state agencies with membership on the
6 council, and to require each budgeted state agency on the council to
7 continue reporting annually until November 1, 2014, to the council on
8 progress made toward the goal of reducing child poverty, and (2)
9 section 4-67v of the general statutes be amended to require the
10 Governor's biennial budget to continue to include a prevention report
11 until the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2020.

To extend annual reporting requirements related to the Child Poverty and Prevention Council.
