AN ACT CONCERNING A SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Education to: (1) Analyze the effectiveness of safe learning policies,
- 3 including antibullying programs, in school districts, and (2) report its
- 4 findings annually to the joint standing committee of the General
- 5 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to education and to
- 6 the select committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 7 matters relating to children.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Education to analyze the effectiveness of safe learning policies, including antibullying programs, and to report annually to certain committees of the General Assembly.
