AN ACT CONCERNING RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that if a retired law
- 2 enforcement officer is eligible, pursuant to 18 USC 926C, to apply for
- 3 photographic identification or certification from the applicable state or
- 4 local agency that such agency issue the photographic identification or
- 5 certification, in accordance with 18 USC 926C, not later than thirty
- 6 days after the date of application by such officer.

Statement of Purpose:

To require state and local agencies to comply with the requirements of the federal Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act of 2004 not later than thirty days after application.
