AN ACT CONCERNING THE SUSPENSION OF MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-80 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, after notice and opportunity for
- 3 hearing in accordance with chapter 54 of the general statutes, shall
- 4 suspend the registration of any motor vehicle that is the subject of (1)
- 5 two or more written warnings issued under the provisions of
- 6 subsection (c) of section 14-103 of the general statutes within a period
- 7 of six months for a violation of subsection (b) of said section 14-103, or
- 8 (2) two or more violations of subsection (b) of said section 14-103
- 9 within a period of six months.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to suspend the registration of any motor vehicle that is the subject of two or more written warnings within a period of six months.
