**AN ACT CONCERNING PROJECTS ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER
THE SMALL TOWN ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 4-66g of the general statutes, establishing the Small
- 2 Town Economic Assistance Program, be amended to make all projects
- 3 ready to be implemented in qualified municipalities eligible for all
- 4 funds under the program.

Statement of Purpose:

To amend the Small Town Economic Assistance Program so that towns can access all approved funds under the program in order to implement projects that are ready to be implemented.
