**AN ACT CONCERNING SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS AND
INDIVIDUAL PRIVACY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 To amend the general statutes to require individuals and business
- 2 entities who maintain records containing social security numbers of
- 3 other persons to delete such numbers from their records not later than
- 4 January 1, 2010, with the exception of employers, who may continue to
- 5 maintain records containing social security numbers of their
- 6 employees.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect the privacy of individuals by requiring the deletion of social security numbers from certain records.
