AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRUCK TRAFFIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the State Traffic
- 2 Commission to adopt clear and precise public standards for the
- 3 approval or disapproval of requests regarding the prohibition of
- 4 through truck traffic on specific streets by municipalities or
- 5 individuals. It is proposed that the State Traffic Commission shall
- 6 adopt similar standards for other traffic control matters, and shall
- 7 publicize such changes through outreach and public information
- 8 initiatives.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the State Traffic Commission to adopt clear and precise public standards for the approval or disapproval of requests regarding the prohibition of through truck traffic on specific streets by municipalities or individuals.
