AN ACT PROVIDING PROPERTY TAX RELIEF TO PERSONS SEVENTY YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER WHO VOLUNTEER IN MUNICIPAL PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That tile 12 of the general statutes be amended to allow
- 2 municipalities to provide property tax credits to persons seventy years
- 3 of age or older who volunteer in programs sponsored by
- 4 municipalities, including, but not limited to, meals-on-wheels and
- 5 library and school programs.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage senior citizens to volunteer for municipal programs by providing property tax credits for their volunteerism.
