***AN ACT CONCERNING PRIVATE SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITIES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 446k of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 privately owned sewage treatment facilities that discharge directly into
- 3 the waters of the state to report compliance with their discharge permit
- 4 to the Department of Environmental Protection on a monthly basis, to
- 5 subject facilities that fail to report to a penalty, and to allow the
- 6 department after notice and a hearing to revoke the discharge permit
- 7 of those facilities that fail to correct any violation of their discharge
- 8 permit within the time period allotted by the department for such
- 9 correction.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To require certain sewage treatment facilities to report monthly to the Department of Environmental Protection and to allow the department to revoke the discharge permit of any facility which fails to comply with its permit requirements.
