**AN ACT EXPANDING THE ROLE OF REGIONAL EMERGENCY
MEDICAL SERVICES COUNCILS AND COORDINATORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368d of the general statutes be amended to clarify and
