AN ACT CONCERNING ALLERGY-FRIENDLY HOTEL ROOMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) require operators of
- 2 hotels, motels or other similar lodgings with at least fifty rooms
- 3 available for rent to designate at least ten per cent of such rooms as
- 4 allergy-friendly rooms, defined as nonsmoking, pet-free rooms that (A)
- 5 contain tile or wood floors, air conditioning units with high efficiency
- 6 particulate air filters and nonallergenic mattress and pillowcase
- 7 coverings, and (B) are free of rugs, carpeting and fabric drapes and
- 8 curtains; (2) establish a complaint procedure for patrons to report
- 9 operators who fail to comply with such requirements; and (3) establish
- 10 fines or other penalties for noncompliance with such requirements.

Statement of Purpose:

To make allergy-friendly hotel rooms available for patrons with allergies and respiratory problems.
