AN ACT CONCERNING USE OF TOBACCO SETTLEMENT FUNDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize the use of tobacco
- 2 settlement funds to purchase vans to transport persons (1) with
- 3 emphysema, cancer or other lung conditions, and (2) who formerly
- 4 used tobacco.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize the use of unallocated tobacco moneys health-related needs caused by smoking.
