AN ACT CONCERNING A SALES TAX EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN SENIOR CITIZENS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 219 of the general statutes be amended to provide an
2 exemption from the sales tax for persons aged sixty-five or older with
3 incomes, excluding state and federal payments, of not more than
4 fifteen thousand dollars per year if single, or thirty thousand dollars
5 per year if married, and with liquid assets not exceeding for
6 homeowners, ten thousand dollars if single or twenty thousand dollars
7 if married, and for renters, seven thousand dollars if single and
8 fourteen thousand dollars if married.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide financial relief to middle class seniors.
