AN ACT CONCERNING USE OF THE SURPLUS FOR AN ENERGY TAX CREDIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that a portion of
2 the General Fund surplus in fiscal year 2007 be used to provide a two
3 hundred seventy-five dollar energy tax credit against the state income
4 tax to each household in Connecticut. This credit shall be payable in
5 full, even if the income tax due is less than two hundred seventy-five
6 dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To use the state surplus to provide a \$275.00 energy tax credit to each household in Connecticut.
