**AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF ALLOWING EMPLOYERS TO PROVIDE GREATER VARIETY OF HEALTH INSURANCE PLANS FOR THEIR EMPLOYEES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the Insurance Commissioner and the Commissioner of  
2 Economic and Community Development shall conduct a study of the  
3 feasibility of allowing employers to provide a greater variety of health  
4 insurance plans to their employees. Such study shall include, but not  
5 be limited to, consultation with experts in the insurance and health  
6 care industries. Not later than January 1, 2008, said commissioners  
7 shall submit a report on their findings and recommendations to the  
8 joint standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance  
9 of matters relating to insurance and commerce, in accordance with  
10 section 11-4a of the general statutes.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To study the feasibility of allowing employers to provide a greater variety of health insurance plans for their employees.
