**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LIFESPAN
RESPITE COALITION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 319y of the general statutes be amended to establish a
- 2 Lifespan Respite Coalition that shall study the issue of respite care and
- 3 make recommendations as to how the state can improve upon the
- 4 availability and delivery of respite care to persons of all ages.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a Lifespan Respite Coalition that shall assess the need and type of respite care necessary in the state and work with state agencies to secure all federal dollars that are available for respite care.
