***AN ACT CONCERNING FARM WINERIES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 30-16 of the general statutes be amended to allow
- 2 grapes to be grown on leased land and to allow the harvest from such
- 3 land to be used to satisfy the requirement that a farm winery permittee
- 4 must produce on his or her farm a crop of fruit not less than twenty-
- 5 five per cent of the fruit used in the manufacture of the farm winery
- 6 permittee's wine.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To allow grapes to be grown on leased land and to allow farmers to use those grapes to satisfy the requirements of a farm winery permit.
