AN ACT CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR YOUTHFUL OFFENDER STATUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 54-76b of the general statutes be amended to exclude a
- 2 motor vehicle violation from the definition of "crime" and thereby
- 3 make a youth who is sixteen or seventeen years of age and is charged
- 4 with a motor vehicle violation ineligible for youthful offender status.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that youths charged with motor vehicle violations are not eligible for youthful offender status.
