AN ACT CONCERNING INTERVENTION BY LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODIES IN BINDING ARBITRATION PROCEEDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that,
2 notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 113 or 166 of the general
3 statutes, whenever the municipal employer engaged in binding
4 arbitration with a municipal employee organization is not the
5 legislative body of such municipality, the legislative body of the
6 municipality, or if the legislative body is a town meeting, the board of
7 selectmen, may by majority vote of the body intervene in such
8 arbitration proceedings.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow legislative bodies of municipalities to intervene in binding arbitration proceedings.
