***AN ACT CONCERNING THE CRIMINALIZATION OF PRETEND
PRIMARIES UNDER THE CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to make the direct
- 2 participation in a primary that is arranged with the intent of receiving
- 3 state funding under the Citizens' Election Program in order to prevail
- 4 in the general election, rather than a legitimate primary, a crime.
