**AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR INCUMBENT WORKER
TRAINING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The sum of two million dollars is
2 appropriated to the Labor Department, from the General Fund, for the
3 fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, for incumbent worker training
4 programs developed by the Connecticut Employment and Training
5 Commission and implemented by the Labor Department, in
6 collaboration with the regional workforce development boards,
7 pursuant to section 31-3h of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
