**AN ACT CONCERNING MODIFICATION OF CHILD SUPPORT
ORDERS INVOLVING TEMPORARY FAMILY ASSISTANCE
RECIPIENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2007*) In any proceeding in the
2 Superior Court or the Family Support Magistrate Division involving
3 modification of a child support order where one of the parties, or a
4 child of the parties, is receiving or has received state aid under the
5 temporary family assistance program, the birth of a child to the minor
6 child for whom the support was ordered, shall not, in and of itself,
7 constitute a substantial change of circumstances so as to permit
8 modification of the child support order.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the Superior Court or the Family Support Magistrate Division from modifying a child support order in a proceeding

involving a party or child who is or was a temporary family assistance recipient.
