AN ACT CONCERNING REDUCTION OF THE MEDICAID SPEND-DOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17b-261 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 the Commissioner of Social Services to reduce, to the extent permitted
- 3 by state and federal law, the Medicaid spend-down amount required
- 4 to qualify for Medicaid funded programs.
