**AN ACT CONCERNING INCOME QUALIFICATION FOR THE
MUNICIPAL OPTION TO PROVIDE REAL PROPERTY TAX RELIEF TO
CERTAIN ELDERLY HOMEOWNERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-17v of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 the income limits for eligibility under the program to fifty thousand
- 3 dollars for individuals and seventy-five thousand dollars for married
- 4 couples.

Statement of Purpose:

To give municipalities an additional tool to protect seniors, who may own their home but live on fixed incomes, from the sudden increase in real property taxes caused by revaluation.
