**AN ACT CONCERNING MAXIMUM ENROLLMENT OF CHILDREN
ELIGIBLE FOR THE HUSKY PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 17b-292 and 17b-297 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to provide that the Department of Social Services shall, to the
- 3 maximum extent permitted by federal law, establish a state-wide
- 4 system of ensuring the enrollment of all children who are eligible for
- 5 subsidized HUSKY Plan, Part A or Part B health insurance benefits.
- 6 The commissioner may contract with entities such as, but not limited
- 7 to, hospitals, clinics, schools and day care providers to effectuate
- 8 enrollment of such children in the HUSKY Plan, Part A or Part B.

Statement of Purpose:

To mandate that all children who are eligible for subsidized HUSKY Plan, Part A or Part B benefits must enroll in the program.
