AN ACT INCREASING PENALTIES FOR THE MANUFACTURE OR SALE OF METHAMPHETAMINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 420b of the general statutes be amended to increase the
- 2 penalty for manufacturing or selling methamphetamine to provide
- 3 that for a first offense, an individual may be fined not more than fifty
- 4 thousand dollars or imprisoned not more than fifteen years, or both,
- 5 for a second offense, an individual may be fined not more than one
- 6 hundred thousand dollars or imprisoned not more than thirty years, or
- 7 both, and for any subsequent offense an individual may be fined not
- 8 more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars or imprisoned not more
- 9 than thirty years, or both.

Statement of Purpose:

To address the public hazard of methamphetamine abuse in our state by increasing the penalties for manufacture or sale of methamphetamine.
