AN ACT CONCERNING CHILDREN OF FAMILIES WITH SERVICE NEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 815t of the general statutes be amended to provide for
- 2 the establishment of service centers for the referral, support and
- 3 treatment of children and other family members of any family that has
- 4 been adjudicated as a family with service needs, and to ensure full
- 5 implementation of the requirement that such children shall not be
- 6 convicted as delinquent or be held or committed in any juvenile
- 7 detention center solely for the violation of an order regulating future
- 8 conduct.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for the establishment of service centers for the referral, support and treatment of children and other family members of any family that has been adjudicated as a family with service needs, and to ensure full implementation of the requirement that such children shall not be convicted as delinquent or be held or committed in any juvenile detention center solely for the violation of an order regulating future conduct.
