**AN ACT CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF STATE MARSHALS
AS SPECIAL POLICEMEN IN CHILD SUPPORT MATTERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 29-1g of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2007*):

3 (a) The Commissioner of Public Safety may appoint not more than
4 four persons nominated by the Commissioner of Social Services as
5 special policemen in the Bureau of Child Support Enforcement of the
6 Department of Social Services for the service of any warrant or capias
7 mittimus issued by the courts on child support matters. Such
8 appointees, having been sworn, shall serve at the pleasure of the
9 Commissioner of Public Safety and, during such tenure, shall have all
10 the powers conferred on state policemen and state marshals.

11 (b) The Commissioner of Public Safety may appoint any state
12 marshal nominated by the State Marshal Commission as a special
13 policeman pursuant to section 2 of this act for the service of any
14 warrant or capias mittimus issued by the courts on child support
15 matters. Such appointee, having been sworn, shall serve at the

16 pleasure of the Commissioner of Public Safety and, during such
17 tenure, shall have all the powers conferred on state policemen.

18 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2007*) The State Marshal
19 Commission may nominate any state marshal in good standing to
20 serve as a special policeman pursuant to section 29-1g of the general
21 statutes, as amended by this act, for the service of any warrant or
22 *capias mittimus* issued by the courts on child support matters.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Sec. 2	<i>October 1, 2007</i>	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To permit the Commissioner of Public Safety to appoint any state marshal nominated by the State Marshal Commission to serve as a special policeman for the service of any warrant or *capias mittimus* issued by the court in a child support matter.
