**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF STATE FUNDS FOR ANTI-LABOR ORGANIZING ACTIVITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit employers that
- 2 receive state funds from using such funds in activities that discourage
- 3 or dissuade employees from exercising their constitutional right to
- 4 freedom of association while engaging in labor organizing activities.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prohibit the use of public funds for anti-union activities.
