**AN ACT CONCERNING LEAVE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES PROVIDING
DISASTER RELIEF SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 5-249 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2007*):

4 (b) Any state employee who is a certified disaster service volunteer
5 of the American Red Cross may, with the authorization of such
6 employee's supervisor, be granted a leave not to exceed [fourteen]
7 fifteen working days in each year to participate in specialized disaster
8 relief services for the American Red Cross, upon the request of the
9 American Red Cross, without loss of pay, vacation time, sick leave or
10 earned overtime accumulation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:

Section 1	<i>October 1, 2007</i>	5-249(b)
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Statement of Purpose:

To extend the length of leave a state employee may be granted to provide disaster relief services for the American Red Cross.
