AN ACT CONCERNING BONDS OF MUNICIPAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 103 of the general statutes, concerning municipal
- 2 sewerage systems, be amended to allow municipalities to finance small
- 3 water and sewer projects with general obligation bonds, provided the
- 4 water pollution control authority agrees to levy user rates to repay the
- 5 municipality, the authority conducts a public hearing on the proposed
- 6 bonds and such bonds are approved by two-thirds of the elected body
- 7 and the water pollution control authority notwithstanding any other
- 8 local approval requirements.

Statement of Purpose:

To make financing of municipal sewerage system improvements more cost effective.
