**AN ACT ALLOWING FOREIGN MEDICAL SCHOOL GRADUATES TO
BECOME LICENSED AS PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 19a of the general statutes be amended to make any
- 2 person who is a graduate of a medical school located outside of the
- 3 United States eligible for licensure as a physician assistant, provided
- 4 such person successfully completes a qualifying examination and has
- 5 three or more years of experience providing patient services in a
- 6 medically underserved area under the supervision, control,
- 7 responsibility and direction of a physician.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow graduates of foreign medical schools to become licensed as physician assistants.
