**AN ACT PROHIBITING SMOKING IN MOTOR VEHICLES WITH CHILDREN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 14 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit anyone
- 2 from smoking in a motor vehicle where a child who is subject to this
- 3 state's child restraint law or seat belt law is a passenger in the motor
- 4 vehicle. A police officer may stop a motor vehicle upon observation of
- 5 a violation of this provision.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To protect children from second-hand smoke.
