AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE TO RESTORE THE JOSEPH N. GOFF HOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 one hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by
- 5 the Department of Economic and Community Development for the
- 6 purpose of a grant to the town of East Hampton to complete the repair
- 7 and restoration of the Joseph N. Goff House.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for the restoration and repair of the Joseph N. Goff House, an historic landmark that will house the memorabilia of former Governor William A. O'Neill.
