**AN ACT CONCERNING HEATING SYSTEM REPLACEMENT FOR
MANSFIELD MIDDLE SCHOOL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That, notwithstanding the provisions of section 10-283 of the general
2 statutes, or any regulation adopted by the State Board of Education
3 pursuant to said section 10-283, concerning ineligible costs, the town of
4 Mansfield shall be eligible to receive a grant for the costs of replacing
5 all or a portion of an electrical heating system with an alternative
6 energy heating system at Mansfield Middle School, provided the
7 school district files an application for such project no later than June
8 30, 2008, and meets all other provisions of chapter 173 of the general
9 statutes and any regulation adopted by the State Board of Education
10 pursuant to said chapter 173, and that, notwithstanding the provisions
11 of section 10-286 of the general statutes, or any regulation adopted by
12 the State Board of Education setting square footage specifications for
13 purposes of calculating eligible costs for a school building project
14 grant, such square footage specifications shall not apply to said project.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide the town of Mansfield with the costs of replacing an electrical heating system with an alternative energy heating system at Mansfield Middle School.
