AN ACT CONCERNING REIMBURSEMENT OF SPECIAL EDUCATION COSTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-76g of the general statutes be amended to reduce the
- 2 reimbursement threshold for special education costs to two and one-
- 3 half times the average per pupil cost.
