AN ACT CONCERNING A CONNECTICUT AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM GRANT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-16x of the general statutes be amended to (1) allow
- 2 the after school grant program to provide funding for professional
- 3 development training and technical assistance to local after school
- 4 programs to improve program quality, enhance coordination and
- 5 maximize resources, (2) allow the Department of Education to use up
- 6 to two per cent of the amount appropriated for the after school grants
- 7 for administrative expenses, (3) require the Department of Education
- 8 to evaluate the effectiveness of the grant program, and (4) require the

9 Department of Education to report biennially to the General Assembly
10 on the benefits and effects on children participating in programs that
11 received grants.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the scope and requirements for the grant program for after school programs.
