**AN ACT CONCERNING THE AGE AT WHICH A CHILD CAN
WITHDRAW FROM PUBLIC EDUCATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to raise the age from
- 2 sixteen to eighteen at which a child can withdraw from public
- 3 education with parental permission.

Statement of Purpose:

To raise the age from sixteen to eighteen at which a child can withdraw from public education with parental permission.
