AN ACT CONCERNING REFORMATION OF THE EDUCATION COST SHARING FORMULA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-262h of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 for an increase in the state's share of the costs of kindergarten through
- 3 grade twelve public education by fully funding the education cost
- 4 sharing formula so that it better reflects the original formula, and by
- 5 (1) increasing the foundation to an amount reflective of actual costs, (2)
- 6 increasing the minimum aid component so that every community
- 7 receives an appropriate minimum level of state aid, and (3) uncapping
- 8 every town.

Statement of Purpose:

To reform the education cost sharing formula so that it better meets the diverse regular and special education needs of our towns and cities.
