AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TAX CREDIT FOR THE RESIDENTIAL USE OF BIOHEAT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 12 of the general statutes be amended to (1) provide a
- 2 credit against the income tax for using bioheat in residential heating or
- 3 hot water heating, and (2) add any diesel fuel blend used for
- 4 residential heating or heating hot water containing not less than five
- 5 per cent biodiesel fuel to the home heating oil exemptions.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish tax credits for bioheat used in home heating or hot water heating .
