AN ACT CONCERNING A SALES AND EXCISE TAX REFUND FOR CERTAIN TAXPAYERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to create a sales
- 2 and excise tax refund program through the state income tax which
- 3 would allow taxpayers to receive a sales and excise tax refund as a
- 4 refundable credit against their state personal income tax liability in an
- 5 amount equal to twenty per cent of the federal Earned Income Tax
- 6 Credit for which they are eligible.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a program to refund part of the taxes taxpayers pay in state sales, gasoline and other excise taxes, based on their income.
