**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ENFORCEMENT OF DEPARTMENT OF
CONSUMER PROTECTION LICENSING STATUTES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That sections 20-341, 21a-7 and 21a-11 of the general statutes be
2 amended to grant the Commissioner of Consumer Protection the
3 authority to impose civil penalties against persons engaged in
4 unlicensed work, to issue discontinuance and restitution orders, hold
5 licensing hearings, suspend and revoke licenses and apply for arrest
6 warrants against persons engaged in unlicensed work.

Statement of Purpose:

To grant the Commissioner of Consumer Protection expanded powers
to protect the public from individuals who engage in occupational
trades without a license.
