**AN ACT TO PROTECT CITIZENS FROM ABUSIVE AND OPPRESSIVE  
AUTOMATED POLITICAL TELEPHONE CALLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to: (1) Create a "Do Not Call"
- 2 registry regarding political telephone calls, (2) regulate the use of
- 3 automated political phone calls by requiring such calls only be made
- 4 by a candidate and not by a political action committee, and (3) require
- 5 any such automated call to contain a statement in the candidate's voice
- 6 indicating the candidate's name and the use of such automated system.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prevent abusive and misleading use of automated telephone solicitation technologies and automatic dialing-announcing devices.
