AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF ADVERTISING SPACE ON STATE PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any
2 provision of the general statutes, the Commissioner of Public Works or
3 the board of trustees of a constituent unit of the state system of higher
4 education may enter into a contract with an advertiser, sponsor or
5 other person for: (1) The placement of commercial advertisements
6 upon state buildings, facilities, stadiums, arenas or theaters, and (2) the
7 naming rights to any such state building, facility, stadium, arena or
8 theater, provided the Commissioner of Public Works or the board of
9 trustees of such constituent unit, as the case may be, determines that
10 such contract is in the best interest of the state or constituent unit, as
11 applicable.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
