AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADJOURNED PRIMARY IN THE EVENT OF A TIE VOTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 9-446 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that if a tie vote occurs in a primary, the primary shall stand
- 3 adjourned, as in an adjourned election in a tie vote, rather than
- 4 dissolving the tie vote by lot, which is done under present law.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for an adjourned primary in a tie vote, rather than the present mandated process of dissolving a tie vote by lot.
