AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE TO ENTER INTO A COMPACT WITH OTHER STATES TO HAVE THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES ELECTED BY POPULAR VOTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize the state to enter
- 2 into a compact with other states that provides for the election of the
- 3 President of the United States by popular vote rather than by the
- 4 electoral college.

Statement of Purpose:

To assure election of the President by popular vote.
