**AN ACT CONCERNING NOTICE TO PARENTS AND STUDENTS OF
USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION PROVIDED BY STUDENTS ON
QUESTIONNAIRES AND SURVEYS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2007*) Each local and regional
2 board of education shall require any high school under its jurisdiction
3 that hosts an informational forum concerning college preparation or
4 the college admission process to which parents and guardians of
5 students are invited to provide such parents and guardians with
6 information about the optional nature of some surveys and questions
7 that accompany examinations taken for college admission. The
8 information provided to parents and guardians shall include a
9 warning that the release of personal identifying information may
10 increase a student's vulnerability to identify theft.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To provide notice to parents of the optional nature of surveys or questions that accompany college admission examinations and to provide warning that the release of personal identifying information may increase a student's vulnerability to identify theft.
