**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ASSET TEST USED TO DETERMINE
ELIGIBILITY FOR THE STATE-ADMINISTERED GENERAL
ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (c) of section 17b-191 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to increase the applicable asset test used to determine
- 3 eligibility for the state-administered general assistance program from
- 4 two hundred fifty dollars to one thousand dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a safety net for individuals who lose state-administered general assistance benefits by increasing the asset test from two hundred fifty dollars to one thousand dollars.
